- 3) I have descended just to save you; other than Myself you have no friend in this world.
- 4) I have brought the medicine that will wipe out the disease of illusion from which you are suffering. Take this mahā-mantra—Hare Kāñēa, Hare Kāñēa, Kāñēa Kāñēa, Hare Hare/Hare Rāma, Hare Rāma Rāma Rāma, Hare Hare."
